

Cow Patty Bingo Rules

Person must be 18 or older to purchase a ticket and/or win a prize. One ticket per square.

Player/Ticket holder need not be present to win.

Player/Ticket holder is responsible for all associated fees/taxes.

No tickets will be sold after the event begins.

The actual grid area will be clearly marked with all squares being of equal shape and size – and the area will be protected with a barrier or fence. Spectators/ticket holders must not interfere with the progress of the event.

At approximately 1:00 pm on June 3, 2017 a cow will be led into the grid area by an appropriate handler and let free to roam within the area until a cow patty is placed on a square or the time allotment of 2 hour(s) has expired. If there is no cow patty by 3 pm, the winner will be determined by a drawing.

The numbered ticket that corresponds with the numbered square that contains the poo deposit will be declared the winner. In the event that the cow poo deposit lands on multiple squares, the square with the largest portion of poo deposit will be declared the winner. The independent judge (who is not allowed to participate in the raffle) will determine the results.

Any disputes or claims must be registered with the judges.

The results or decision of the judges will be publicly posted.

The organization must post the “Rules” so all participants understand the conduct of the event.

We are anticipating selling all squares. 1/3 of the profit from the entire sale will be awarded as the prize, and the remaining 2/3 will go to Pope Memorial SPCA.
